WHAT IS EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING?

experiential learning without having the expected educational outcomes articulated and related to the curriculum Participative The student must be involved in the process Experiential learning is active rather than passive Rather than just listening to a lecture, students do role plays, or make decisions (as in a simulation game), or perform
